

What the Nuke Masterclass offers

A Live Online Masterclass is designer for those who want to become experts in special effects for cinema. During the VFX Compositing Master course, you'll learn the top techniques in the industry. You'll start with the basics and move on to more advanced skills like green screen work, 3D integration, and matte painting.

Each week, you'll have 12 hours of classes, exercises, and projects to practice what you've learned. The fifth week is all about finishing up your final projects and polishing your portfolio to get you ready for the industry.

We do not provide recordings of the lessons, but if you wish, you are free to do so.








We will teach you how to approach software logically, so you can intuitively choose the most useful tools and commands to create incredible images and animations.

The instructor for this Masterclass is Alessandro Maschietto, Senior Compositor and Compositing Mentor.




At the end of the Masterclass, we will issue you a certificate certified by Skyup Academy.

Import image sequences and learn the basics of Nuke's node-based workflow;

- Fundamentals of color correction and white balance;
- Rotoscoping techniques to isolate objects or characters from their backgrounds, allowing you to manipulate or replace elements within a scene;
- 2D tracking to record the movements of twodimensional objects within a video sequence, enabling the addition of elements in a way that is consistent with the movement of the image;
- Interactive lighting techniques to adjust or modify the light from computer-generated elements with filmed scenes.




Introduction to VFX compositing




Advanced Compositing Techniques

- Background removal and replacement from scenes filmed in green or blue screen;
- 3D tracking: camera movement analysis to insert
 3D elements;
- Removal of unwanted elements in the filmed scene;
- Camera projection, which allows you to recreate the camera's perspective from the original shot on 3D geometries, to enable new, subtle camera movements.

- Use the render passes provided from 3D files to reassemble them in Nuke. You will have maximum control of lights and colors to manage the scene as needed;
- Learn how to integrate 3D elements into 2D shots, applying all the acquired knowledge: tracking, projections, color correction...





Practices and standards

- Learn to manage nodes in an organized way and have a clean and optimized project, to be ready to meet corporate standards;
- Discover advanced techniques to optimize steps, speed up the workflow, and methods to efficiently manage file size.

Put into practice, everything you have learned to in the chorus by delivering a complete shot, which you can personalize to have a high-level element for your showreel.

Alessandro Maschietto will follow you step by step, simulating production reviews, to help you solidify the concepts and finish a professional showreel.



Final project and review






